




Qualtrics is an online survey tool (similar to Survey Monkey) for creating and posting online surveys, collecting data, and generating reports. It is widely used by social and behavioral science researchers, in particular, because users can easily set up experimental designs (e.g., random assignment to conditions, randomized or counterbalanced question order), integrate Qualtrics surveys with SONA Systems and Amazon Mechanical Turk, and download data in an SPSS data file (and other file formats) with variable and response scale information automatically entered. Qualtrics is incredibly user-friendly and there is excellent online and over-the-phone support for both survey design instruction and troubleshooting.

The SAM Lab recently purchased a Qualtrics site license that extends to all students, faculty, and staff affiliated with New College. <u>To sign up for a **new** ASU Qualtrics account</u>, follow the steps below:


1. Go to MyASU and click on "MyApps" in the left menu bar.



- 2. Click on the "Resources" tab and select "Software Request." For students, this is an essential step. (If you search for Qualtrics in the general "MyApps" search window, you will be brought to a page where the only visible options for requesting access are for Faculty and Staff.)
- 3. A Software Request Form will open, with your name and ASURITE ID already filled in.
- 4. In the "Software Options" dropdown box, select "Qualtrics."
- 5. For "Request Type," select "Access."
 - NOTE: You should be able to leave the "Device Type" and "Operating System" fields blank. (If you are a student, your "Device Type" will most likely be "Personal." You can designate your computer's

operating system, however, this information should be irrelevant because Qualtrics is a web-based software.)

- 6. Enter any computer name that you'd like.
- 7. For "Software Purpose," indicate whether you'll be using Qualtrics primarily for teaching, research, or administrative purposes.



- 8. In the "Description" box, you will need to indicate that you are a [Student / Staff / Faculty] in the New College of Interdisciplinary Arts & Sciences, that we have Qualtrics license for our college, and that you would like access to Qualtrics.
- 9. After submitting the form, you will receive a UTO Ticket Number for your request. You should receive follow up information within a day or two with an update on your Qualtrics account status.

Once you have Qualtrics access, you will be able to login with your ASURITE ID and share/collaborate projects with other ASU people on http://asu.qualtrics.com/. If you already have a Qualtrics account, you can access your account directly on http://asu.qualtrics.com.
